

**CITY OF SCHULENBURG

The City Council of the City of Schulenburg met in special session on Monday, August 23rd, 2021, at 5:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers located at 607 Upton Avenue, Schulenburg, Texas. The elected officials present included Mayor, Elaine Kocian, Aldermen, Wendy Fietsam, Larry Veselka, Ben Herzik, and Clarence Ahlschlager. City Staff present were City Administrator, Tami Walker, and Human Resources Officer, Mason Florus.

Visitors included, Iván Velasquez.

Mayor Kocian called role.

Mrs. Walker led discussion on setting a Public Hearing Date for the Proposed Tax Rate. Mrs. Walker recommended that the hearing be set before the next regular Council Meeting on September 7th.

Alderman Veselka made a motion, seconded by Alderman Herzik, to set the Public Hearing for Tuesday, September 7th, at 5:45 P.M. at the Council Chambers. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Walker led discussion on concrete bids received for Keuper Avenue.

Mrs. Walker informed Council that no bids were received. Therefore, no action was taken on this item.

Mayor Kocian announced that her and Alderman Thomas met with former Boy Scout leaders this past Saturday and the Scout leaders removed everything they wanted from the Boy Scout Hut, located on East Avenue between the Food Pantry and the Warehouse. Mayor stated that she will meet with Dianna Zimmermann of the Schulenburg Historical Museum tomorrow and see if the museum will want any memorabilia. After Mayor meets with Mrs. Zimmermann, the City will dispose of everything left behind in the Hut and tear down the structure.

Mrs. Walker wanted to inform the other members of Council that Mayor and Alderman Veselka made an effort to purchase 100 American Flags that will be displayed around town at various times of the year.

Alderman Veselka stated that Mike Grahmann of Grahmann's True Value, gave the City a good deal on conduit pipe. Alderman Veselka continued saying that the Street Department welded steaks on the pipe and that is what will be driven into the ground and hold the flags.

Alderman Veselka made a motion, seconded by Alderman Herzik, to adjourn the meeting at 5:15. The motion passed unanimously.
