The City Council of the City of Schulenburg conducted a workshop to discuss the future of garbage and roll-off services for the City of Schulenburg on Monday, November 29, 2021, at 6:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers located at 607 Upton Avenue, Schulenburg, Texas. The elected officials present included Mayor, Elaine Kocian, Aldermen, Greg Thomas, Wendy Fietsam, Larry Veselka, Ben Herzik, and Clarence Ahlschlager. City Staff present were City Administrator, Tami Walker, Operations Manager, Darryl Moeller, and City Secretary, Mason Florus.

Council discussed the option of continuing with the City's current garbage operations or contract out garbage services. There was a general consensus and Council instructed Mrs. Walker to go out on RFP after January 1, 2022 and get bids for contracting garbage services. A final decision will be made once more information is gathered.
