

**CITY OF SCHULENBURG
SCHULENBURG, TX
April, 27, 2022**

The City Council of the City of Schulenburg met in a Special Meeting on Wednesday, April 27th, 2022, at 6:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers located at 607 Upton Avenue, Schulenburg, Texas. The elected officials present included Mayor Elaine Kocian, Greg Thomas, Wendy Fietsam, Ben Herzik, Clarence Ahlschlager, and Larry Veselka. City Staff present were City Administrator, Tami Walker, and Operations Manager, Darryl Moeller.

Visitors included Howard Stoner and Iván Velasquez.

Mayor Kocian called the meeting to order.

City Council adjourned into an Executive Session to discuss the following pursuant to Government Code, 551.071 Consultation with Attorney and 551.072 Deliberation about Real Property. Consultation with the City Attorney regarding purchase of property located at 1003 Kallus Street. And, consultation with City Attorney regarding Multi-Use Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for property located at Interstate 10 and Highway 77.

The time was 6:01p.m.

City Council reconvened into an Open Session at 7:13p.m.

Mayor Kocian called for action on the items discussed in Executive Session. Alderman Wendy Fietsam made a motion, seconded by Alderman Greg Thomas, to authorize the city to continue with the purchase of property at 1003 Kallus Street for the sum of \$30k contingent on conditions discussed in Executive Session and to authorize staff to finalize documents for sale of the property and authorize the mayor to execute same. Motion passed unanimously.

Alderman Veselka made a motion, seconded by Alderman Herzik, to adjourn the meeting at 7:14p.m. The motion passed unanimously.
