

**CITY OF SCHULENBURG  
SCHULENBURG, TX  
December 15, 2025**

The City Council of the City of Schulenburg met in regular session on Monday, December 15, 2025, at 6:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers located at 607 Upton Avenue, Schulenburg, Texas. The elected officials present included Mayor Pro Tem Clarence Ahlschlager, Alderwoman, Kathy Kleiber, Aldermen, Greg Thomas, Frank Wick III, and Roger Moellenberndt. City staff present included City Administrator, Tami Walker, Police Sergeant, Terry "Rusty" Roggenkamp, Public Works Director, Darryl Moeller, and City Secretary, Mason Florus.

Visitors included Layne Vyvjala of the Schulenburg Sticker, Benjamin Cohen with Crowe LLP, and Michael Ohnheiser.

Mayor Pro Tem Ahlschlager called role. Mason Florus said a prayer over the meeting and its members. Mayor Pro Tem Ahlschlager led the Pledge of Allegiance and the Texas Pledge.

Under Presentations, Proclamations and Recognitions, Benjamin Cohen with Crowe LLP presented the City of Schulenburg's Audit for Fiscal Year 2024.

Mr. Cohen announced that the City's former Auditor, Belt Harris Pechacek, is now a part of Crowe LLP. He acknowledged that there were some "growing pains" with the new methodology and software. Mr. Cohen joined the project in October to assist and he's confident moving forward, the City and Crowe's working relationship will remain strong.

The Audit Draft was included in Council's Packets. Mr. Cohen turned Council's attention to The Independent Auditor's Report where there was an "Unmodified Opinion" which is the highest level of assurance the firm can issue.

Mr. Cohen also highlighted that the ending net position has remained consistent over the years. He did mention one finding involving the EDC, but continued that it was rectified with a journal entry.

Alderman Wick made a motion, seconded by Alderman Thomas, to accept Consent Agenda Items A and B. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Walker led discussion on rescheduling the Regular Scheduled Meeting set for February 16<sup>th</sup>, due to Presidents' Day.

Mrs. Walker reminded Council that it's common practice to move the meeting to the day after the Holiday. These decisions are planed in advance for board and commission hearing purposes.

Alderwoman Kleiber made a motion, seconded by Alderman Moellenberndt, to move the meeting to Tuesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Works Director, Darryl Moeller's report was included in Council's Packets.

City Administrator, Tami Walker, reported to Council that the Contract for City Hall has been read by the Attorney and sent back to PGAL for the contractor to sign. There was mention of the City possibly having to acquire Builder's Risk Insurance. Once the City receives clarity from TML on the Builder's Risk Insurance, the contractor can begin the demo work. Said work will more than likely begin by the end of this week.

Alderman Moellenberndt made a motion, seconded by Alderwoman Kleiber, to adjourn the meeting at 6:49. The motion passed unanimously.
